# Tax Reform, Low Inventory Could Slow Housing

Home sales should increase by 3.7 percent to 5.67 million in 2018, and prices next rise will rise by about 5.5 percent, NAR Chief Economist Lawrence Yun said during the 2017 REALTORS® Conference & Expo in Chicago. But the housing industry's growth prospects—and the economy's—could be tempered by the continuing inventory shortage and the possibility of changes to the tax code that could damage the real estate market, Yun said at forum on residential economic issues and trends.

# Changes to Appraiser Qualifications Proposed

The Appraisal Qualifications Board (AQB) has proposed several key changes to the requirements for people who want to become appraisers, including no longer requiring a bachelor's degree for licensed residential appraisers and accepting five years of experience and other certain other education instead of a bachelor's degree from people looking to become certified residential appraisers. ## Rural Area Definition Revised

The Department of Agriculture has released updated guidance for determining if an area is Rural in Character as part of a periodic review Among the criteria field offices will now consider are whether an area faces high unemployment, is losing residents, or has a transient population. Details.
